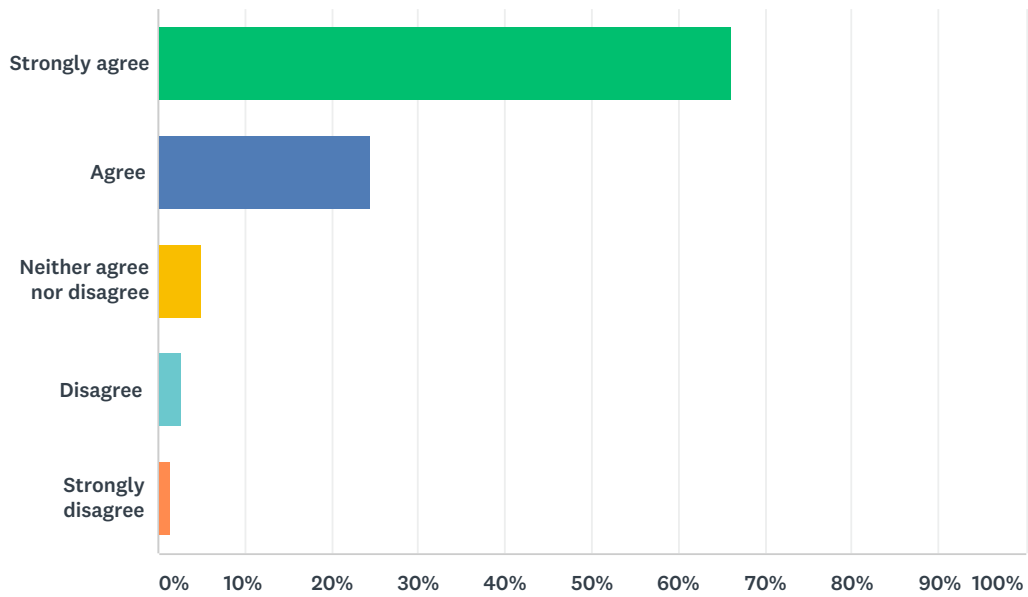


Q1 Please mark how strongly you agree or disagree with this statement: City park facilities make Mansfield a more livable community?

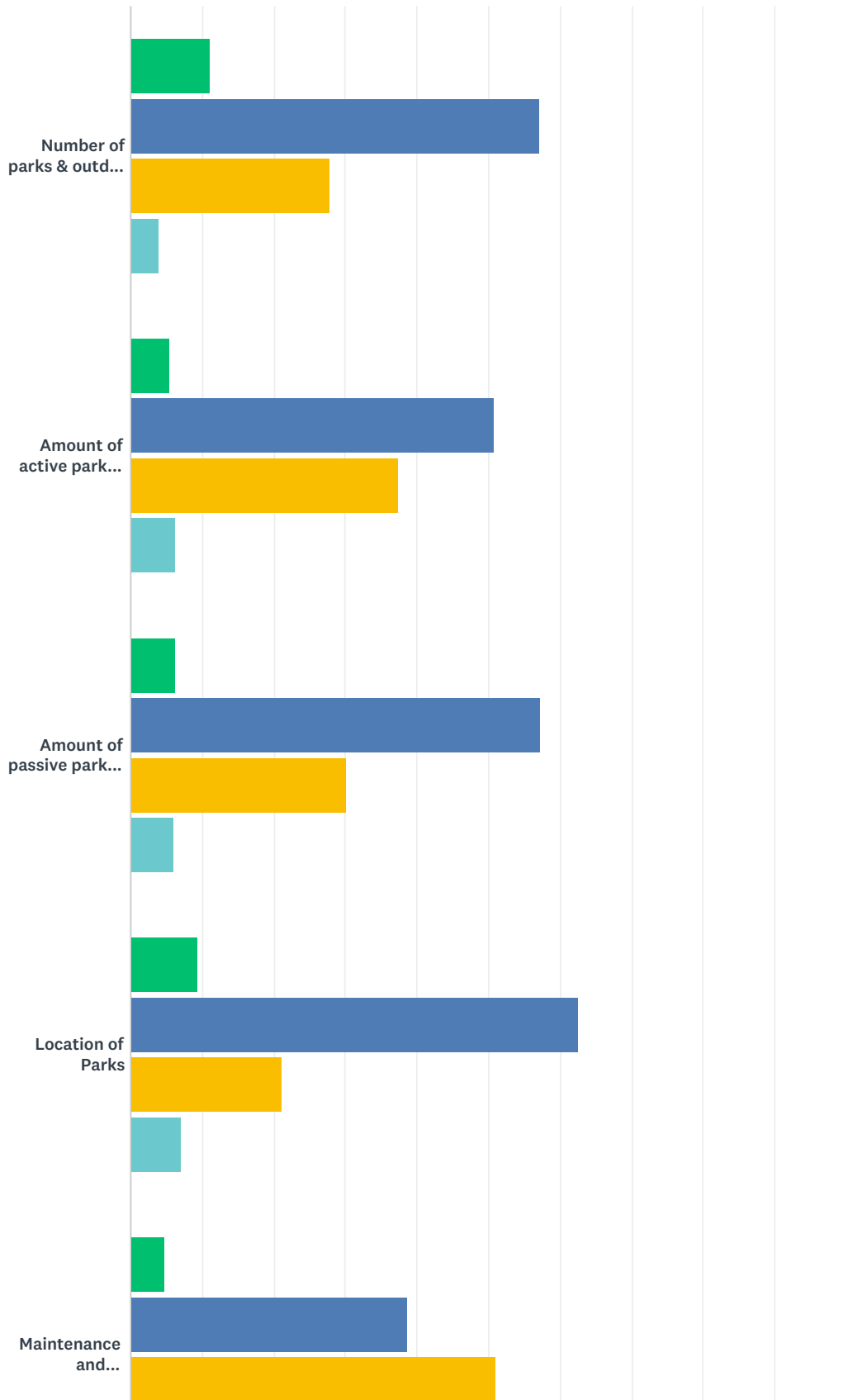

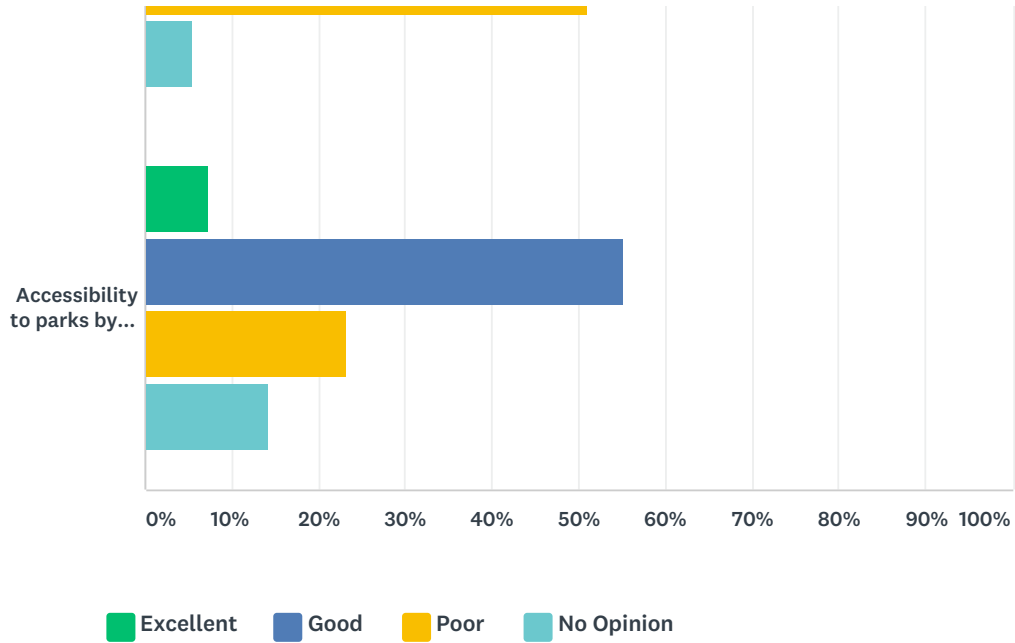

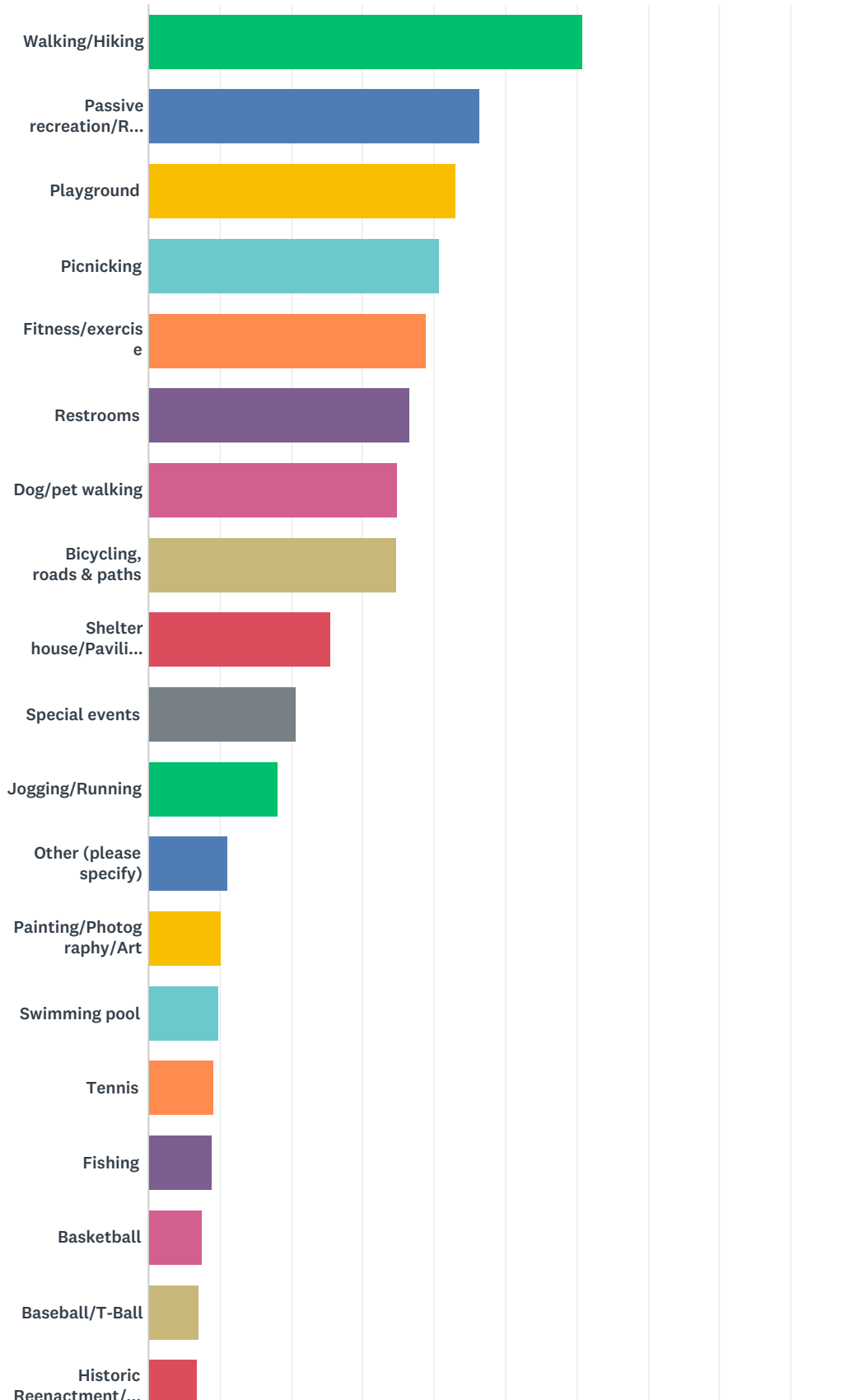

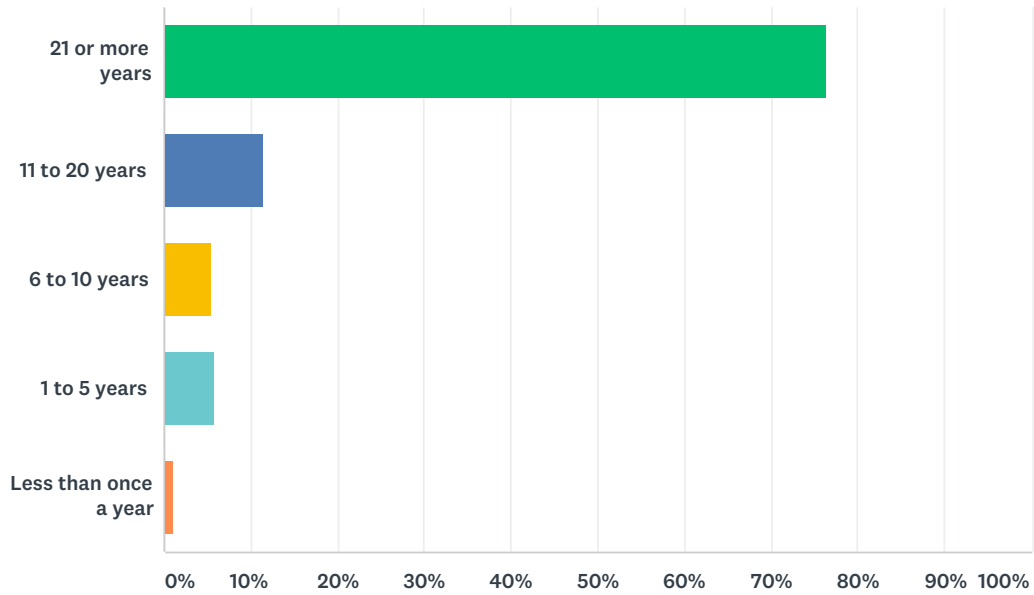

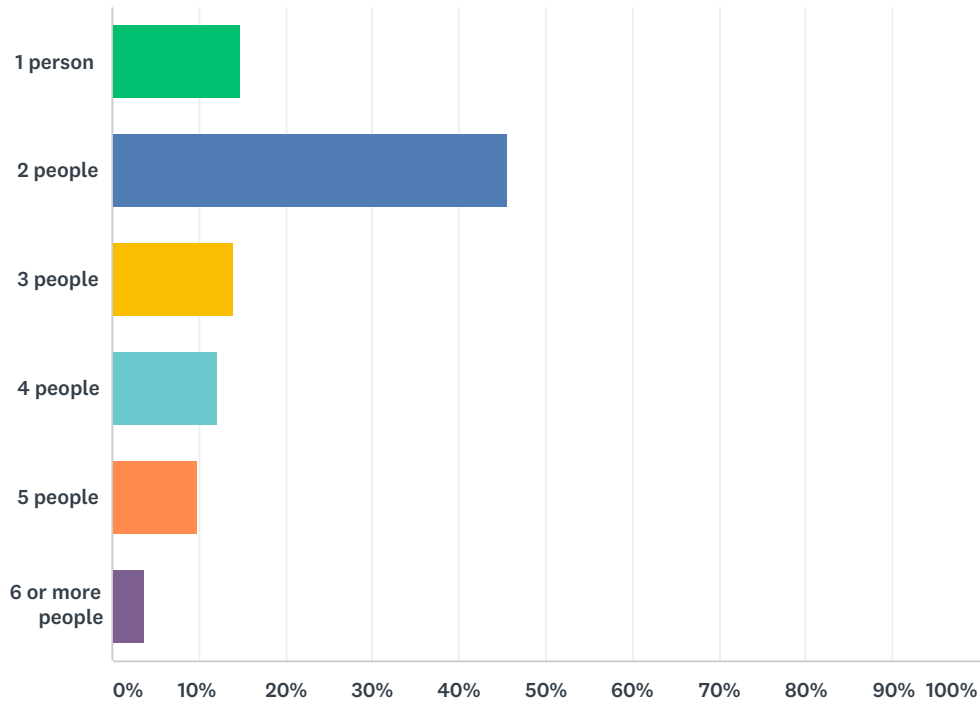

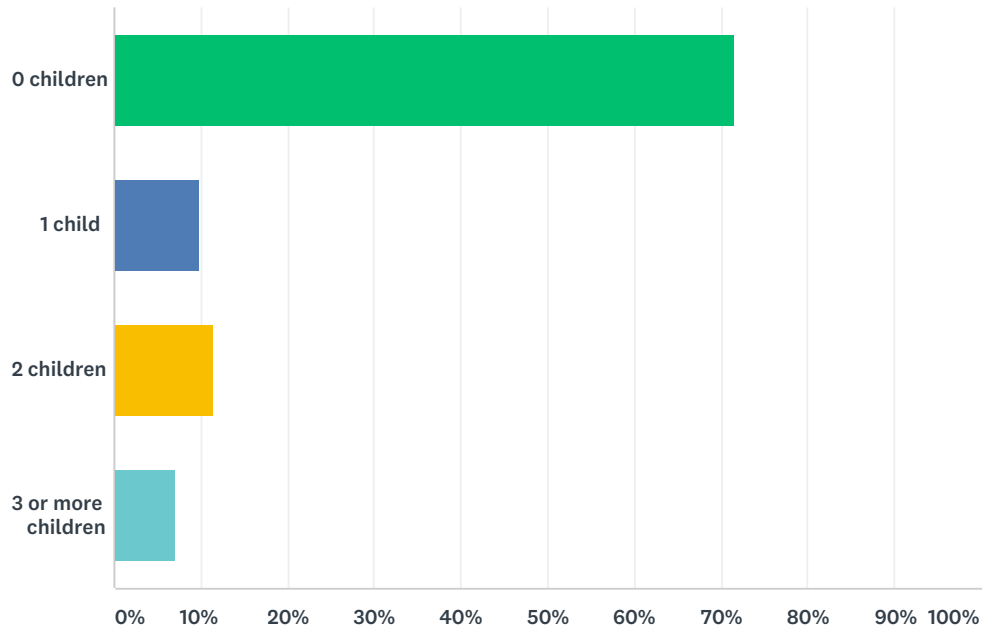

Q11 How many school age children reside in your household?

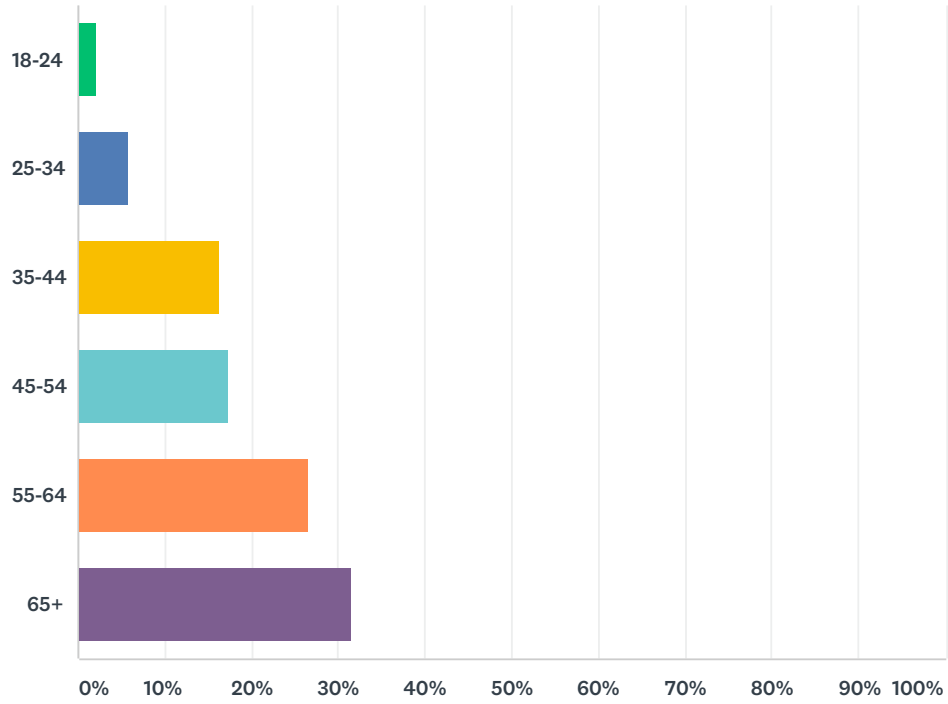

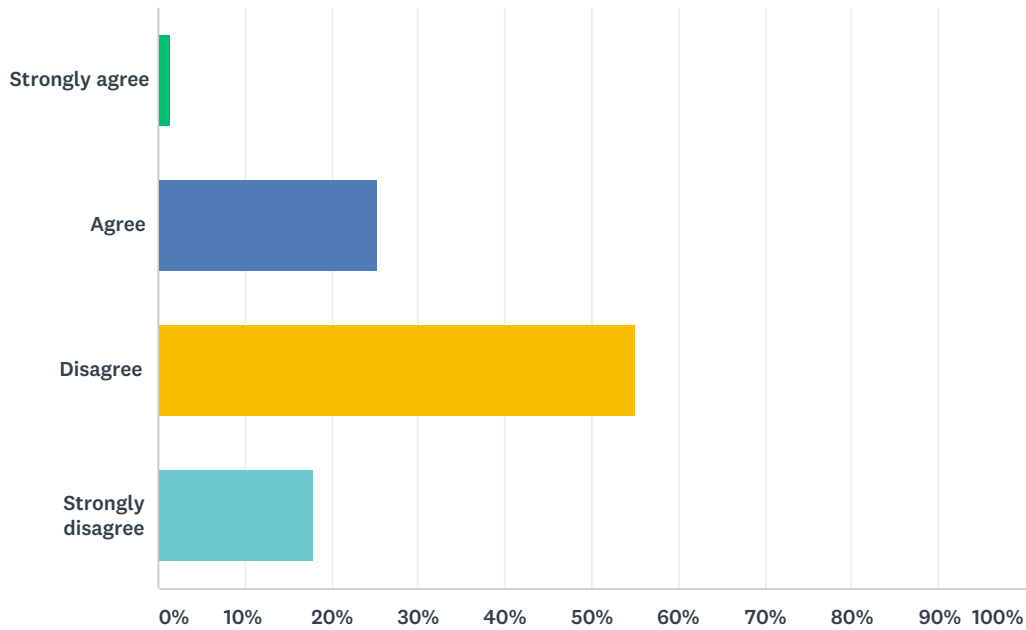

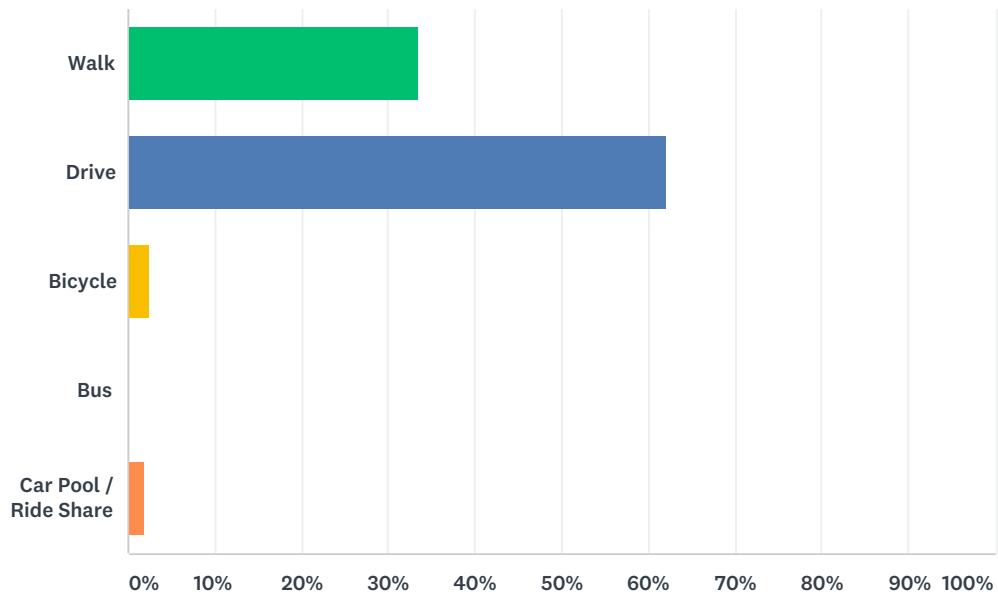

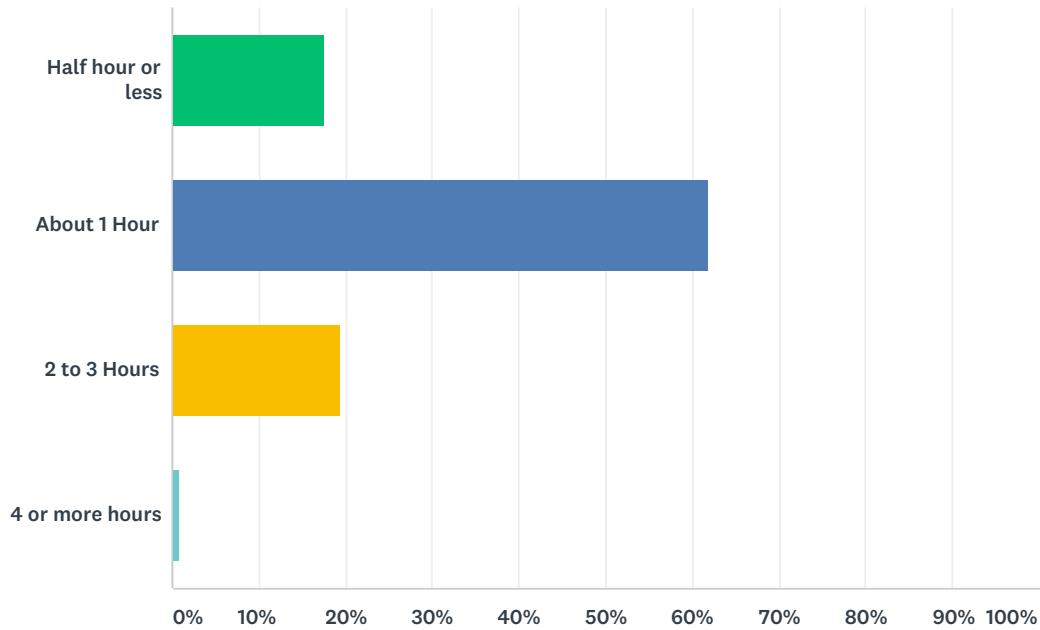
