## Re: Ohio clergy representing 160 congregations call for swift passage of Human Life Protection Act

Psalm 127 says, "Children are a heritage of the LORD, and the fruit of the womb is his reward. As arrows in the hand of a mighty man; so are children of the youth. Happy is the man that hath his quiver full of them...."

As one hundred -sixty faith leaders across Ohio, we thank GOD for the recent Supreme Court decision to reverse the 1973 Roe v. Wade court opinion. (1) Abortion is infanticide and never was a right expressly written in the U.S. Constitution. This diabolical decision allowed the murder of an unborn child on demand up to birth, (2) led to the untimely deaths of at least sixty-three million unborn children (3) and caused America to be a reproach among the nations. (4)

To be clear, abortion is not health care. Abortion is murder that takes the life of an unborn child and can cause grave physical harm to the mother and emotional harm to both the mother (5) and father (6).

As a result of the Supreme Court reversal, it is our understanding restrictions on abortion can now be determined at the state level as prescribed in the Tenth Amendment. Presently abortion in Ohio is banned at or around six weeks of pregnancy (when a heartbeat is detected) except in cases of life endangerment of the mother. While this Heartbeat Law is important, moral clarity surrounding the unborn should be strengthened by eliminating legislative loopholes.

Over the past decade, the General Assembly has demonstrated Ohio is a pro-life state with more than thirty abortion restrictions enacted since 2011.(7) We believe the "Human Life Protection Act," currently in committee, can reinforce this reputation. The following provisions in the bill we support include: (8)(9)

- No person shall purposely take the life of a child born by attempted abortion who is alive when removed from the uterus of the pregnant woman. Whoever violates this section is guilty of abortion manslaughter, a felony of the first degree, punishable by a minimum of four and a maximum of twenty-five years of imprisonment and a fine of not more than ten thousand dollars
- ❖ A woman on whom an abortion was performed in violation of sections 2904.03, 2904.04, or 2904.05 of the Revised Code may file a civil action for the wrongful death of her unborn child if the violation was a proximate cause of the death of her unborn child with the only exception when the abortion was necessary to prevent the death of the pregnant woman or a serious risk of the substantial and irreversible impairment of a major bodily function of the pregnant woman
- No person shall purposely manufacture, possess for sale or distribution, advertise, or hold oneself out as possessing for sale or distribution, or sell or distribute, any drugs, medicine, instrument, or device, Whoever violates this section is guilty of promoting abortion, a misdemeanor of the first degree
- The state medical board shall revoke a physician's license to practice medicine in this state if the physician is guilty of any violations of sections 2904.03 to 2904.05 of the Revised Code

All things considered, the "Human Life Protection Act" H.B. 598 and its companion S.B. 123 will effectively ban abortion in the State of Ohio. As clergy representing one hundred and sixty (160) diverse congregations throughout Ohio Heartland, we believe in human dignity and that life begins at conception. Therefore, we are calling on the General Assembly to swiftly pass the Human Life Protection Act and for the Governor to sign it into law. By the same token, we expect the Attorney General, County Prosecutors, and Municipal Law Directors to fulfill their duties and enforce this law.

Some things do not change. Historically, clergy in the region have advocated for the lives of unborn babies with Down Syndrome (10) and supported the defunding of Planned Parenthood. (11) Additionally, with the advent of ultrasound technology, science is catching up with what the Bible already stated thousands of years prior: life begins at conception. As Psalm 22:10 says, "I was cast upon thee from the womb: thou are my GOD from my mother's belly."

Thank you for taking our thoughts on the sanctity of life into careful consideration. Choose life not death, our future generations are depending on it.
