Open Letter to Donald J. Trump Sent electronically to the Office of Donald J. Trump on October 16, 2024

Dear President Trump,

Thank you for your courage in fighting systemic corruption in Washington D.C. As Ohio faith leaders, we believe you are a man of destiny.
