On the listed date and time I was dispatched to the listed location along with Sgt. Henderson, Deputy Skeen, and Deputy Knee. Upon arrival at the scene I observed multiple vehicles leaving and multiple people walking down the drive from the listed location. At this time a Bellville unit was standing by trying to get as many RPs as possible that were leaving the listed location. When pulling up to the house numerous people were walking out and trying to enter cars. At that time they were told to stop and stand by in grass across from the listed location.

As I entered the listed location with Sgt. Henderson I observed one victim a few feet from the doorway with a stated gun shot would to his side. There were still numerous people inside the home, at this point other officers and I advised everyone to exit the listed location and stand by in the grass across from the listed location. As they exited a black male stated he was shot in the foot, he was attempting to get into a Chevy Avalanche RP MP ONE along with 3 other individuals. This is when the other black male who was also attempting to sit in the back stated he was shot. I did not visually see the wound and stated where and he did not answer. I had to advised them that they could not leave. They were attempting to leave to drive to the hospital. This is when I advised them the squad was almost there and to stay seated. I asked again if anyone else was wounded and they replied no. At that point in time the other victim still did not advise me where he was injured.

As more people exited the home I continued to tell them to stand by on the grass to be identified. During this Deputy Knee and the Bellville unit started to identify all the individuals standing by through Dispatch. OSP also arrived on scene to assist. All officers involved had to repeatedly ask people to stop trying to leave and stand by why we identified them. I continued to stand by and check on the two injured individuals, advising them again they can't leave and the squad was almost there while doing this I assisted in identify multiple individuals.

Once the EMTs were on scene they were immediately advised of the victim inside the listed location and the two in the vehicle. The EMTs assisted the two individuals into there squad at that time the other injured individual stated he was shot in the leg. This is when the EMTs advised they were transporting the two individuals to Ohio Health and that when they took off a shoe off one of the victims a shell casing fell out and they secured it for us.

Once the listed location was cleared and the surrounding scene was found to be safe I began getting statements from individuals who stated they seen the incident. The majority of people that were asked by officers what happened stated they didn't see anything. I spoke with Jaziyia Thomas who stated to me that the victim who was inside the listed location, sister said it was Damira Rawals who was the shooter. Jaziyia competed a statement for me. I collected statements from a couple more individuals at the listed location.

This is when I started to talk to the individuals in the other cottages around the listed location. The two individuals from cottage 128 stated that about 4 people came to there cottage yelling and asking for help saying people were shot. I collected statements from both individuals. I also spoke to a male in cottage 113 who stated he didn't here anything and then completed a statement for me. The other individual I spoke with in cottage 106 stated he heard the noise and gun shots and completed a statement. I logged the RPs that were in from of cottages 128,106, and 113. I continued to check all the other cottages 114,112,111,110,109,107,108,105,103,104,101,102,106, and 121-127 I did not observe any other

Deputies were dispatched to 3230 Possum Run Rd. in reference to a report of a shooting with at least one person that had been shot. While en route I requested dispatch to check with Post 70 of the Ohio State Highway Patrol to see if they had some available units that may have been closer to assist. Deputy Skeen advised that he had by that location approximately 30 mins. prior to this call and he had seen at least 20 to 30 vehicles parked at in the lower lot, which would have been visible from the roadway. This was very unusual for this place of business. I requested dispatch to contact Mansfield Police Department to see if they were able to send a couple of units to assist until we established what the situation was. I also requested Bellville Police Dept. to assist. I was aware of that unit having an in car camera system that could record the vehicles that were parked in the lower area. Deputy Skeen advised that he was almost at the location and Ptl. Wallis from Bellville Police advised that he was in the area. I advised both units to stand by at the entrance and try to get as many license plates that they could of the vehicles leaving. Just prior to this Deputy Skeen advised that he was on Possum Run Rd. and that there was a steady line of cars traveling towards St. Rt. 13. I observed approximately 20-40 cars on Possum Run Rd. traveling towards St Rt. 13 between Spruce Hill Cottages and German Church Rd. Upon arrival to Spruce Hill Cottages entrance I proceeded up the hill to the cottages to attempt to locate a victim. I observed several vehicles in the area of the entrance while going up the hill. I observed numerous people walking down the hill as I was going up the hill. Once I got to the top of the hill I observed numerous people exiting the area of a large house. I went to the front of that large house and more people were exiting the front entrance. I observed a black male being assisted in walking, he was in the middle of two others. I was advised that he was shot in the foot. I asked if there were any other injuries and was advised no, I advised them to have him seated by the stairs and wait for EMS, I advised dispatch that there was a second shooting victim.

I approached the entrance up to the large house and more people were exiting the front door. There was a black male yelling about the ambulance not being there and he was yelling that he knew who did it and it was going to be on. I advised deputies behind me to try and get his information as I was going into the house to begin to clear it and look for victims. I observed a railing that was broken on the front porch that was in the landscaping as if it was pushed over. I observed inside of the front door about three feet on the floor was a black male later identified as, Ja`quan Durrell, on the floor laying on his left side. There were people around him and they advised that he had been shot. I had Ja`quan speak to me and check his eyes, which were equal and reactive to light. He spoke very lightly but knew his surroundings. I checked for a possible gunshot wound, which one was located on his right side mid torso area. Pressure was applied to his wound which was round and consistent with a gunshot wound. I did not observe any blood pooling around him and I did not see an exit wound. I observed casings from what appeared to be from a smaller caliber handgun on the floor near the victim and these were not touched but were moved from the victim squirming around and the others trying to help Ja`quan and from EMS. I assisted in first aid until the EMS arrived. While I was assisting I was advised that EMS was having trouble getting up the hill due to the slippery drive conditions and the continuing weather conditions, which it was snowing. I was also advised that there were cars going down the hill, the

drive is a one lane drive. Once EMS arrived they began treatment and transported Ja`quan to Ohio Health.

Deputy Skeen entered the residence after I did and began taking pictures of the scene immediately to try to preserve any evidence and get a layout of the residence. Deputy Skeen advised that he located other casings.

Assisting agencies arrived, Mansfield Police and Ohio State Highway Patrol arrived on scene to assist. They assisted in making sure the house was clear and no other persons were found to be hiding. To my knowledge the house was empty at this time. Prior to this there was a light skin black male wearing shorts and a t shirt that was in the house and he was advised to get out and another officer was advised to identify him.

About this time I was advised that there were two other persons at the Ohio Health Emergency Room that were there for gunshot wounds that were at the house at the Spruce Hill Cottages.

Capt. Zehner and Capt. Sweat were notified of the incident. Later I was advised that there was a fifth gunshot victim related to this incident.

I further checked around the house and observed that a lower window behind a Christmas tree was broken and the screen pushed outward as if someone had fallen through the window. Above that window at a second story level another window had a hole in it indicating a shot went through that window. These windows would be in the main room or living room of the house further inside the front door.

The floor was sticky and there was a strong odor of burnt marijuana inside the residence and just outside the residence. Deputy Skeen began a log of persons coming and going from the inside of the residence. Other officers from other agencies and Deputies attempted to at least get as many people identified as possible as they were leaving, most of these persons were advised to stay. Statements were obtained from as many as could be before being released or they left without permission.

I checked the perimeter of the house and found a couple sets of footprints going away from the house into the wooded area. There were a number of footprints on the back porch/patio area and around the right side of the house(if looking at the house from the front) and coming around front to the parking area and leaving towards the exit to go down the hill.

Capt. Sweat and Capt. Zehner arrived on scene. I secured from the area of the house and went to the entrance where there were a couple of vehicles that were stuck in the drives. These occupants were identified and statements were

obtained from them. On the statement forms were notes about which car they came from and that they were at the bottom of the hill.

I made contact with an employee of Spruce Hill Cottages, Elizabeth Clark and obtained a statement from her and she advised that an Xavier Hess rented the house as she referred to as the Manor for a get together with friends and he arrived about 1515 hrs on 12/29/16 with two others, Jeffrey Swinning and Ameer Culliver. Mrs. Clark advised Xavier was given the key and they went up to the Manor and then left. She further advised that they were surprised about the number of cars parked in the front the Manor and around the property and more were coming and she called Xavier and told him that the amount of people were unacceptable and he needed to turn away the people and he told her that he would not allow any more people there and ended the call. I obtained a copy of the name and hand written receipt of the transaction with Xavier and a copy of the identification cards that she obtained when the Manor was rented. I inquired about cameras on the property and was advised that there were no cameras in the cottage areas and the ones around the office were on but not recording.

Capt. Sweat was given the statement forms. I secured and went to the Ohio Health Emergency Room. Two more witnesses were located in the lobby. One was the sister of Ja`quan. A statement was taken from her.

Throughout the course of obtaining statements I was advised that this party was posted on social media advertising a pre new years party. I located a post on Facebook advertising a Pre New Years Eve "Turn UP' LGKB KBLG Bash Dec. 29th 9 - whenever location: Sprucehill Manor House Females 2\$ and Dudes 5\$ Humble Grind productions.

Friday December 30th, 2016 I responded to the Spruce Hill Cottages on Possum Run Rd, in reference to a shooting.

Dispatch advised a subject had been shot. Units from Bellville PD, Mansfield PD, and Ohio State Highway Patrol also responded to assist. As I arrived on scene there were several people walking down the hill from the cabins. After getting up to the cabins I went to the big house. I went up to the front door and there was a subject down on the floor, just inside the front door. I could also smell a strong odor of marijuana in this area. Sgt. Henderson advised to start identifying people on scene. There were numerous people near the house. Deputy Liggett, Officer Wallace of Bellville PD, and I began running the subjects on scene thru dispatch.

Note: Standing outside the front door of the house I could see a gunshot in a window on the opposite side of the house. There was also a spent shell casing on the step up to the front door.

At one point Officer Wallace advised me of a possible juvenile warrant on one of the subjects there. The juvenile in question (Aychaja Hamilton 15yoa) had an FTA warrant out of the Court of Common Pleas of Richland County Ohio-Juvenile Division and was taken into custody by another unit and placed in Sgt. Henderson's cruiser. I assisted Sgt. Henderson in taping off the crime scene. Sgt. Henderson later advised to take Hamilton to the Juvenile Detention Center and then respond to the hospital. I transported Hamilton to the Juvenile Detention Center to be held. After arriving at the Detention Center and while waiting to be let inside the sally port I spoke to Hamilton about the shooting. Hamilton advised she had been at the house and left because a fight was about to break out. Hamilton said she got to the parking lot and heard several shots. Hamilton said she did not know which people were about to fight. Hamilton said she heard that an Andre and Jaquon had been shot. Hamilton did not know their last names, but said if it is the Jaquon she knows his last name is Brown.

I then responded to the hospital to assist the Detective Bureau there. I administered Gunshot Residue kits on two of the subjects at the hospital who had been shot, Andre Craig and Marvin Parker. I turned these kits over to Detective Lewis.

I later secured from the hospital.

I was called to the Spruce Hill Cottages in reference to a shooting. I had noticed when I was buy this location about a half hour prior that there were a large number of vehicles there. I responded emergency status to the scene.

As I turned onto Possum Run Road I observed a large amount of vehicle traffic coming from the area of the call. I knew the vehicles were not from the ski area because I had only observed two vehicles in the lot earlier. At the entrance to Spruce Hill I observed several vehicles attempting to leave. It appeared as if many vehicles had already left.

I was the first to arrive, so I stood by at the bottom of the hill for other units to arrive. Bellville unit Don Wallis, and Sgt Henderson soon arrived. I followed Sgt. Henderson to the location of the victim. On our way up the hill many people could be seen leaving on foot. They were pointing in the direction of a large house on the property. Sgt. Henderson and I went to the front of the house. Many people were still exiting the house as we approached. One was seen being assisted by two others. I was advised he had been shot in the foot. A black male was located inside the front door. He was later identified as Jaquan J. Brown. He was lying on his right side and several people were rendering aid. His head was in a south west direction. Sgt Henderson tended to the victim. I went to clear the home. As I went room to room I took photos as I went. There was a strong odor of burnt marijuana inside the entire house. The last of the subjects left the home as I checked it. The photos will be placed into evidence.

Sgt. Henderson started getting witnesses together. I tended to the victim until the squad arrived. The victim was shot in the left side a few inches above the hip line. There was not a great deal of blood.

Near the victim and throughout the lower front of the home were several shell casings. Most appeared to be .380 or 9mm, but one along a wall just west of the victim appeared to be a .25 caliber. I took photos before they could be disturbed. A bullet hole was observed in a second story window on the north side of the home. A shell casing and blood drop was located outside of the front door. A paper bag was placed over it to keep it as secure as possible. The casings were disturbed during the call due to the emergency squad response, and occupants fleeing the scene.

I started a scene log at 0059 hours. Supervisors were notified by Sgt. Henderson. Other units at the scene were Deputy W Liggett, and Deputy A Knee. Officers from other agencies include Donald Wallis from Bellville PD, Troopers EA Williams, SD Gillum, DP Nelson, RJ Noblet, and Sgt Murfield from the Ohio State Highway Patrol. Sgt D. Rhinehart , J Cikity, S. Gess, and D. Kiner of the Mansfield Police Department. Richland County Sheriff's Office supervisors were Capt. J Sweat, and Capt. D Zehner.

I held the scene until I was relieved by Deputy Liggett. This will be shown on the scene log. Multiple written statements were obtained and will be submitted with this case.

I returned a phone call to Det. Lewis and Capt Sweat in reference to a report of a Shooting Incident with multiple subjects that had been shot while at a party in Manor House at Spruce Hill Cottages on Possum Run Rd. near Snow Trails.

INVESTIGATION:

0200 hours. I responded to Ohio Health Mansfield ER. Upon entering the room I recorded video of subjects that were in the ER area and asked if anyone there was at the party. At this time no one came forward and no one admitted to being at the party at the Spruce Hill Cottages by Snow Trails.

I made contact with Det. Lewis and Sheriff Sheldon, where I was informed that there were five subjects in the ER that had injuries related to the Shooting Incident at 2330 Possum Run Rd. Mansfield.

One of the subjects identified as Jaquan Brown had serious life threatening injuries from apparent gunshot wound.

The other four subjects were identified as, Marvin Parker, Damauri Rawls, Darion Powell, and Andre Craig. These subjects were being treated for non-life threatening injuries and were conscious and able to be interviewed regarding the shooting.

DAMAURI RAWLS INTERVIEW/STATEMENT:

I made contact with Damauri Rawls at Ohio Health Mansfield ER room # 7. He sustained injury from an apparent gunshot to his left shoulder/arm. A taped statement was obtained for transcription.

In essence Damauri Rawls claimed that he was he arrived at the party at about 11:30 pm with Marvin Parker. He indicated that the shooting occurred at about 30 minutes after midnight.

Damauri related that he was in the middle of the living room area where everyone was dancing and there was a song playing and people jumping around. He said that he saw some people arguing, "little dudes" that were underclass or younger than him and they were arguing and pushing each other and then the shots were fired. Damauri stated that he didn't recognize them and didn't remember what they were wearing. He also claimed that he only seen pushing and never saw a gun.

I showed Damauri the video of the subjects in the waiting room to see if he recognized them as being at the party. He claimed to know most of them, but couldn't or wouldn't identify any of them as being at the party.

Damauri was familiar with Marvin Parker, Andre Craig, and Jaquan Brown, but didn't know the name Darion Powell.

Damauri said that he knew the majority of the people at the party. I asked him who would have been near him at the time and he said that there were some females standing beside him, Mahogany, Destiny and Alexis.

Damauri said that he was brought to the hospital by Diamond Brown and Kiki. He thought her last name might be Crawford.

I completed a Gun Shot Residue collection kit on both of Damauri's hands which were bagged. He indicated that he has not washed his hands since the incident.

I explained the reason for the test and asked him what he thought the results would show and he indicated that they would show that he didn't shoot a gun. I noticed that Damauri smiled after making that remark, which I thought was a bit odd.

Damauri's cell phone had been collected as evidence. I asked him what type of phone he had and he stated that it was an iPhone 6 and related that the service was with Page Plus; however, he would not provide the unlock code for the phone. He was advised that I would contact his probation officer and that he may be required to provide the code.

At about 0405 hours. I made contact with Andre Craig at Ohio Health ER room #5. Det. Lewis had already obtained some information from Andre.

He said that he drove himself to the party and that the squad transported him to the hospital. Andre said that the party was advertised on Facebook, Snapchat, and Twitter. Andre had sustained injury to his left and right thighs. He indicated that he was sitting down when he was shot and that he heard a couple shots before he felt the sting from being shot. Nobody else was sitting with him. He related that he was sitting on a ledge facing the dance floor, which was directly in front of him.

Andre indicated that he knew Xavier and the other two people that rented the house for the party and he also knows the other subjects that were also shot and at the hospital.

Andre indicted that the music on at the time was a Chief Keef song and everyone started jumping around. Andre didn't know where Damauri was at when the shooting started.

I showed Andre the video of the subjects that were in the waiting room at the hospital. He stated that he recognized some of them as being at the party, but didn't know anyone by name.

I obtained a recorded statement for transcription from Andre Craig. (See transcription for further.)

Dep. Knee completed a GSR (Gunshot Residue Kit) on Andre.

NALA BROWN INTERVIEW/STATEMENT:

I had obtained information from Sgt. Henderson regarding information about Jaquan Brown's sister, Nala Brown, having information about the shooting incident.

I reviewed the written statement made by Nala Brown, in which she stated, "Ja`quan and Damauri were arguing and I stepped in between them, pushed Ja`quan back." She further related that she turned one way and then another and saw a gun, heard shots and moved to the side. She indicated that she saw Ja`quan on the floor in front of the door and found that he was shot, then applied pressure. She said that she let someone talk to 911 while she talked to Ja`quan to keep him up until the ambulance arrived.

Det. Lewis and I made contact with Nala Brown in one of the hospital rooms just past triage. Nala Brown is 17 years of age and her mother Felisha Kennabrew was also in the room with her.

Nala indicated that she found out about the party from people sending it to her on Snap Chat and Facebook. She indicated that she arrived at about 11:30 hours. Nala said that she was with her friend Tyronica Davis, who is also Ja`Quan's girlfriend and Makenzie. Nala wasn't certain of what time the shooting happened but indicated that it was about 12:40 am.

Nala said that she was walking around and wasn't dancing, when she saw her brother and Damauri in a conflict with

each other. She indicated that Ja`Quan was yelling and at Damauri and she pushed him back. Nala said that she didn't know what they were arguing about. She indicated that she saw a gun, but couldn't tell who had the gun. She related that she heard more than four shots. She related that she saw the flash from at least four shots.

Nala made a rough sketch of the room and where Ja`Quan was located (Facing toward the fireplace and in the direction of bedroom.) She indicated that Damauri was opposite of Ja`Quan with his back toward the fireplace. Nala said that she initially went toward the rail that is along the bedroom hall when the shooting started. I asked Nala to estimate about how many people would have been on the opposite side of Ja`Quan in the area of where Damauri was and she estimated about 20 people.

I asked Nala who else was around at the time of the shooting and she said that she thinks that Mahogany was there and she was pretty sure that Mahogany told her that Ja`Quan was shot. She also said that Alexi Douglas, Terrance "Turtle" Harris was there, but didn't know where he was at during the shooting. She indicated that a TaHaji McNeal and Trevon Moffet OT was also there.

I asked Nala if Ja`Quan goes by any other names or nicknames. She said he is sometimes called "Q Money." I asked her if Ja`Quan was involved in any gangs or associated with gang members and she indicated that she hangs around them, but has friends with K Block or 5th Block and N. Side. She stated that he hangs out with "Teah" a lot.

I asked Nala what she recalled Damauri wearing and she said that he had on a Grey Sweatshirt. She said that Terrence has on an all-black sweat suit and Mahogany was wearing Jeans and a white shirt. I asked her was Ja`Quan was wearing and she said that he had on his Black Jacket with red stitching at the seams.

She said that she didn't think Ameer Culliver was in the house at the time of the shooting.
