CLERGY JOINT STATEMENT ON OHIO ISSUE 1

On November 7th, 2023, Ohioans will decide on Issue 1, whether to "VOTE NO" to defend the life and liberty of parents and children, or whether to enshrine arbitrary and undefined 'reproductive decisions' into Ohio's Constitution. According to the drafted language, (1) the proposed right to be authorized into the Constitution is: "Every individual has a right to make and carry out one's own reproductive decisions, including **but not limited to** decisions on contraception, fertility treatment, continuing one's own pregnancy, miscarriage care, and abortion." (Italics ours)

An approved constitutional amendment becomes the highest law of the land and may bring sweeping changes with it. If Issue 1 passes with a majority vote, existing laws on the books involving abortion, parental consent, and protection of minors will be considered legally invalid based on the ambiguous right of "reproductive decisions." As lead clergymen from one hundred seventy-one (171) congregations, we believe the language of Issue 1 is deceptively vague and detrimental to the basic, inalienable, and GOD-given rights of parents and children. In fact, parents and children are not even mentioned in Issue 1.

We agree with credible healthcare professionals who say abortion is never medically necessary to protect the life of a mother in a high-risk pregnancy. (2) Unfortunately, Issue 1 will enshrine the special right to kill an already existing human being living in his or her mother's womb. Based on the language drafted by the billion-dollar Planned Parenthood organization, this radical pro-abortion constitutional amendment will permit the abortion/murder of unborn babies throughout all nine months of pregnancy, even after heartbeat detection and after an unborn baby can feel pain.

In Deuteronomy 27, the Bible says, "Cursed be he that taketh reward to slay an innocent person."

Because of the indistinct language describing 'reproductive decisions,' Issue 1 will impose a blank check of abuses to occur on Ohio children including but not limited to: gender-selective abortions, trans-surgeries on minors, castration of children's sexual organs, harvesting of body parts, and even cloning. In other words, Issue 1 will allow child abuse to exponentially increase without parents even knowing.

The language of Issue 1 also says "Abortion may be prohibited after fetal viability." (Italics ours.) Fetal viability would be determined by the subjective opinion of an abortionist doctor treating the pregnant woman. Abortion-providers like Planned Parenthood, who make a killing off the murder of children in the womb, will be protected because they can claim exclusive authority by defining viability and avoid any form of liability for terminating the lives of babies.

Unfortunately, an approved constitutional amendment is much harder to reverse than laws which can be changed with each legislative session. If this wicked Issue 1 passes, the Ohio Legislature will not be able to modify or regulate this language. Further, this diabolical language cannot be challenged in Ohio's Supreme Court since the Court is obligated by law to abide by the State Constitution as approved by the voters of the state.

In Matthew 18, the Bible vigorously says, "But who so shall offend one of these little ones which believe in me, it were better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and that he were drowned in the depth of the sea."

In closing, the Ohio faith community has consistently advocated for the sanctity of life and also advocated for moral clarity regarding childhood sexuality. (3-7) With the mandate from GOD, we will not be silent on issues affecting our culture.

As key stakeholders from one hundred seventy-one (171) diverse congregations across 23 counties, we support the sanctity of life and believe the anti-family Issue 1 will normalize child abuse and strip parents of their God-given roles to raise their own children. This Fall on Tuesday November 7th, we encourage Ohioans to protect life and "VOTE NO" on Issue 1.
